

MASTER TRAINER CERTIFICATION POLICY INITIAL AND RENEWAL

Please find below the require steps by Stanford to attain and maintain Master Trainer status for any of their self-management programs.

- 1. Attend a full master training successfully (successful means that the T-Trainers recommend you for Master Trainer)
- 2. Facilitate 2 complete 6-week workshops within 6 months (preferred) and no later than 12 months from date you completed master training. (if you have done this as a Leader before you attended master training you get credit for what you did in the past)
- 3. Fill out and send to Stanford Patient Education Research Center the 2-page Master Trainer Certification Form (incomplete forms will delay the process).
- 4. Stanford will update the trainers' database and website and will mail back your certification notification.
- 5. At that point you are considered to be a Certified Master Trainer. You may conduct Leader trainings at that point.
- 6. The 12 month period starts from the date of your certification; not the date of your training.

Example:

- Master training completed on January 15, 2011
- Met facilitation of 2 full series of workshops by July 15, 2011 (6 mos. from date of training);
- Mails out the signed Master Trainer Authorization & Agreement Form to Stanford and receives certification
- To maintain certification: Need to conduct a 4-day Leader training anywhere between July 2011 and July 2012.
